



Proposition 65 Compliance Declaration

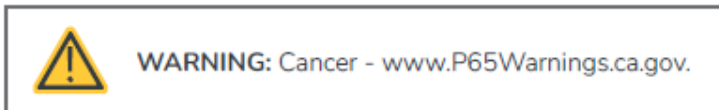

Dear Customer,

Semtech Corporation, in cooperation with our suppliers, continuously strives to adhere to industry standards regarding environmentally safe practices and processes. One aspect of our commitment is compliance with California Proposition 65, also known as the “Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986.” This compliance extends to any materials used in the fabrication or assembly of Semtech IC products.

While Semtech Corporation primarily follows a fabless business model, meaning we do not fabricate or assemble products within the state of California, we recognize that our products may still find their way into California. Our due diligence indicates that some of our products may contain substances identified by Proposition 65. These substances are embedded in the homogeneous materials and are not intended to expose any person during normal product use. Accordingly, the Prop 65 “clear and reasonable” warnings requirements do not apply to Semtech products and evaluation kits.
